Estimated cost is \$30,000-\$35,000. • The initiative team is building a documentation trail of issues at the camp. • The city is actively working with partners to see that services are provided for the homeless. The goal is to help the homeless choose "next steps" in life rather than staying in their current situation. • The best way Fletcher Place residents can help is by volunteering at Horizon House or the Pour House. • Other facts: Indianapolis has 44 homeless camps. Of the homeless, 168 are truly displaced.
